Grand Valley State University - Allendale, MI

- GVSU has a beautiful campus with inspirational structures such as the Transformational Link and gorgeous architecture seen in buildings like the Mary Idema Pew Library.
- This school has three different styles of housing (traditional, suite, and apartment).

Oakland Community College - Multiple Campuses
