The Air Force:

Responsibility

- They are responsible for missile security, defending air bases around the globe, law enforcement on those bases, combat arms and handling military working dogs.

Benefits

1. \$ 34,000 - \$5
2. 5,000 a year.
3. Medical/dental insurance for self and family
4. Takes cares of basic needs
 - Living expenses
 - Food allowances

General Requirements/Recruitments for the Air Force

1. Good vision
2. No allergies
3. Military/Basic training
4. Technical training

The Army:

Responsibility

- The army is responsible to protect the country and its citizens.

Benefits

1. \$ 29,791 - \$ 109,417 a year.
2. They receive \$60,000 in tuition.
3. 20 years + of service begin receiving benefits the day they retire.
4. Medical/dental insurance for him/her and whole family.

General Requirements/Recruitments for the Army

1. Meet with a recruiter
2. Have the required documents

3. Academic evaluation
4. Physical fitness evaluation
5. Look for the Army career that best fits you
6. Prepare for basic training

The Marines:

Responsibility

- Marines are trained and equipped to answer threats all over the world because our nation has interests beyond the borders of the United States.

Benefits

1. \$25,132 - \$ 87,061 a year.
2. 40 + years of service they are eligible for 100% of basic pay at retirement.
3. Medical/dental insurance for self and family.
4. Takes care of basic needs
 - Living expenses and food

General Requirements/Recruitment for the Marines

1. To be enlisted you need to be 17-28 y/o, a legal resident, pass the physical exam, and have a high school diploma
2. To be an officer you must be 18-27 y/o, a U.S. resident, pass the physical exam, have a high school diploma and a bachelor's degree

The National Guard:

Responsibility

- The National Guard is more than just a job. As a Guard Soldier you'll respond when disaster strikes at home. You'll also answer the call when your country needs you around the world. This is their unique dual mission—serving both community and country.

Benefits:

1. \$ 37,284 - 93,462 a year.
2. 2.5 days paid vacation per month, 30 days each year
3. Pay for college with Montgomery GI bill
4. Medical and dental insurance for self and family

General Requirements/Recruitments for the National Guard

1. Fill out a contact form
2. Take an eligibility test
3. Enlist
4. Prepare for basic training
5. Ship out

The Navy:

Responsibility

- The Navy maintains, trains, and equips combat-ready naval forces capable of winning wars, deterring aggression and maintaining the freedom of the seas.

Benefits:

1. \$ 47,380 - \$ 88,044 a year.
2. Absence of state income allowance.
3. Pay for clothes
4. 20 + years of service are eligible for retirement.
